ITINERARY



DAY 1

Upon arrival in Kasane, you will be met at the airport and transferred to Sandpiper Villas Chobe. Depending on your arrival time, the wildlife experience begins with a visit to the Caracal Wildlife Centre. In the afternoon, choose to visit the CARACAL Biodiversity Center for an up-close conservation experience or unwind with a rejuvenating spa treatment. Overnight at Sandpipers.



DAY 2

The day begins with an early morning game drive in Chobe National Park, offering exceptional wildlife viewing in their natural habitat. Return to Kasane mid-morning to enjoy a relaxed coffee and cake before exploring the local street market. End the day off with a magical sunset cruise along the iconic Chobe River, where elephants gather at the water's edge and the sky glows in rich African sunset colours.

ITINERARY

DAY 3

Enjoy a side trip today to Zambia to explore the national park surrounding the iconic Victoria Falls. Walk through rainforest trails and take in breathtaking views of one of the world's greatest natural wonders before relaxing over lunch at a scenic vantage point overlooking the falls. Return to Kasane by nightfall.



DAY 4

After breakfast, travel south toward Nata, passing through the vast broadacre farming landscapes of Pandamatenga. Continue to Elephant Sands Lodge, a truly unique setting where elephants roam freely and gather at the freshwater waterhole directly in front of the restaurant. Enjoy a buffet dinner while observing these magnificent animals in remarkably close proximity, an unforgettable safari moment.

DAY 5

After breakfast, depart for the bird sanctuary on the edge of the vast Sua Pan, which at certain times of the year becomes home to over 70,000 flamingoes. Continue to Nata Lodge for lunch before motoring on to Gweta. The evening is at leisure.

DAY 6

Set out early for a drive onto Ntwetwe Pan, home to the engaging habituated meerkats. Spend time observing these fascinating creatures before meeting members of San Bushmen community, who demonstrate traditional survival skills in the desert environment. Return to the lodge for brunch, then continue on to Maun and check in at Crocodile Camp Safari & Spa, beautifully set along the Thamalakane River. Depending on arrival time, the afternoon offers the option of a relaxing river cruise along the Thamalakane River or a spa treatment at the camp (subject to availability). The evening is at leisure. Overnight at Crocodile Camp.

DAY 7

After breakfast, depart for a half-day mokoro excursion into the Okavango Delta channels. Guided by experienced polers, guests glide quietly through reeds and waterways, spotting birds and learning about this unique wetland ecosystem.

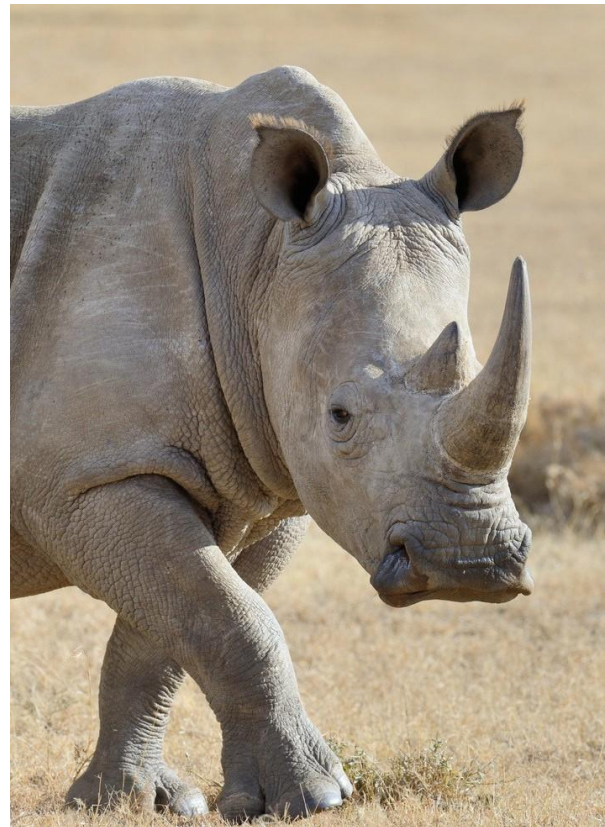
In the afternoon, visit Elephant Havens — a respected elephant orphanage dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation, and reintegration of orphaned and abandoned elephant calves. Guests gain insight into elephant conservation efforts in Botswana and the stories of individual elephants currently in care.

Return to camp for a relaxed evening.
Overnight: Crocodile Camp

ITINERARY

DAY 8

Take to the skies for an early morning scenic flight over the Okavango Delta, where breathtaking aerial views reveal shimmering floodplains, winding waterways, and wildlife below. Later in the morning, enjoy a cultural exploration of Maun, including a visit to the Nhaba Museum and time to explore local craft markets known for their traditional basket weaving. A visit to Women Against Rape offers insight into important advocacy and empowerment initiatives supporting women in Botswana. In the afternoon, travel onward toward the Boteti River region. Overnight at Boteti River Camp.

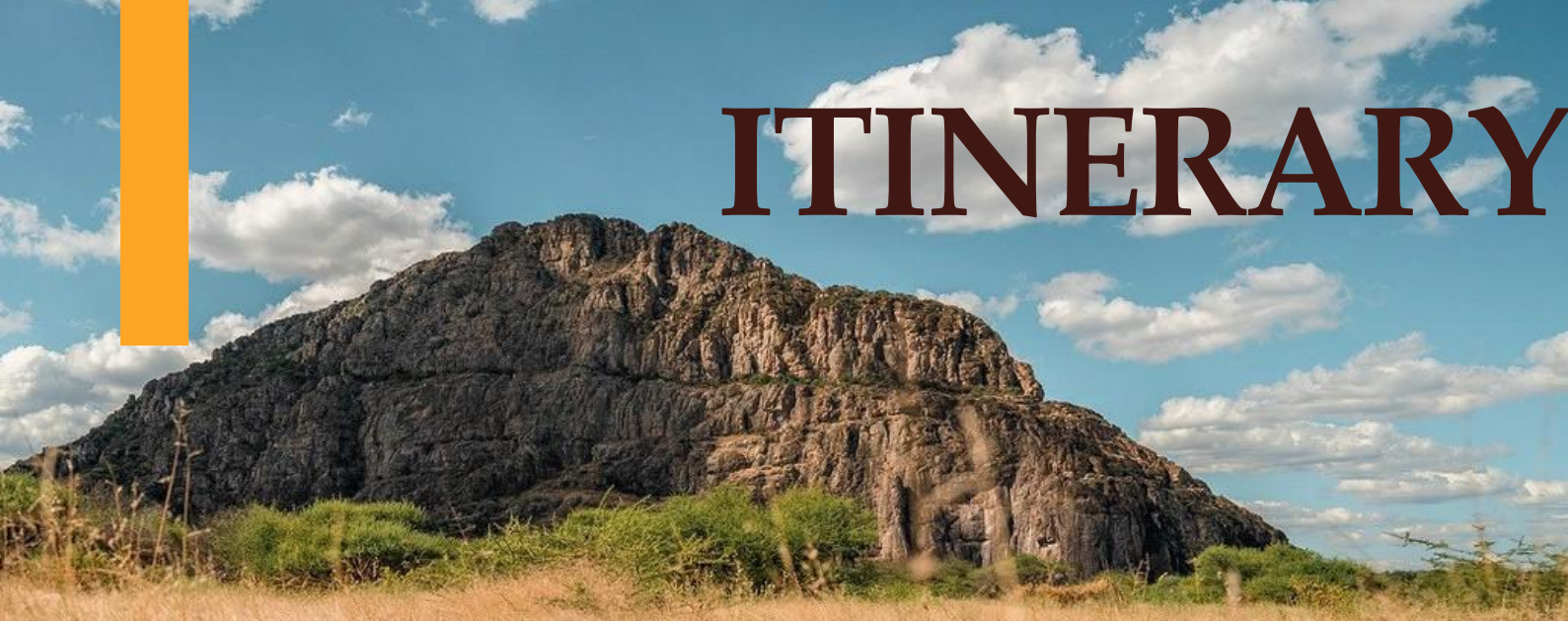


DAY 9

Set out early for a morning game drive along the Boteti River, an area renowned for its impressive elephant and zebra movements. Afterward, travel south toward Orapa, enjoying a packed lunch en route or stopping in Rakops for a local meal. In the afternoon, continue with a game drive in Orapa Game Park, a lesser-visited reserve offering diverse wildlife and a more secluded safari experience. Overnight at Phudzi Hotel.

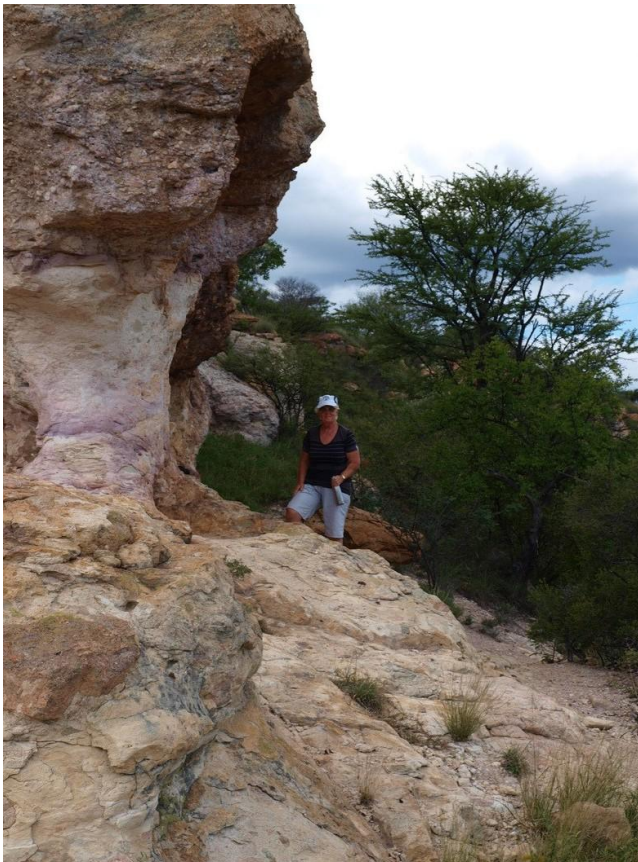
DAY 10

Begin the day with a morning visit to the Orapa Diamond Mine and its museum, gaining insight into Botswana's diamond industry and its significant role in national development. Afterwards, enjoy lunch in Letlhakane at an authentic Setswana street food vendor before continuing on to Serowe. Overnight at Cycad Palm Hotel



DAY 11

Spend the morning exploring the cultural heart of Serowe with visits to the Khama III Memorial Museum and the Royal Cemetery. An Old Mall tour with Bame offers a deeper look into traditional Setswana foods, crafts, and local trade. In the afternoon, continue to Segaiyai Farm for a unique wild foods foraging experience, followed by dinner under the stars. The experience includes meeting and feeding the farm's resident porcupines, a memorable and intimate wildlife encounter. Overnight at Majestic Five Hotel.



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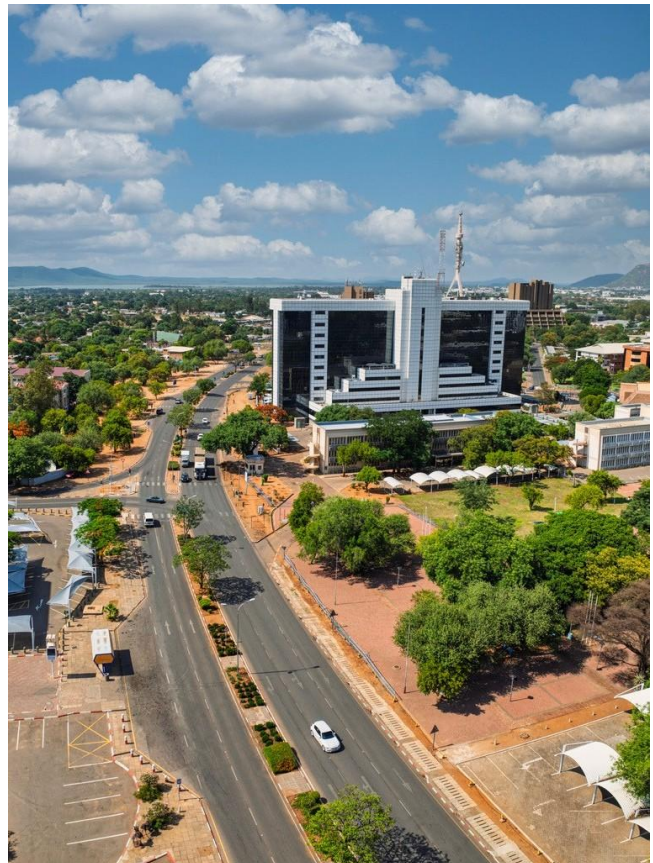
DAY 12

Travel south to Gaborone with meaningful stops along the way. Visit Phala Road Primary School (weekday only) to experience Botswana's public education system firsthand, and pause for a photo at the iconic Tropic of Capricorn.

Upon arrival in Gaborone, visit a local diamond dealer for insight into Botswana's renowned diamond industry, then explore Thapong Visual Arts Centre, a vibrant creative hub supporting contemporary artists through exhibitions, workshops, and cultural preservation. Overnight at Aquarian Tide Hotel.

DAY 13

A tour of the capital will take in landmarks of the No. 1 Ladies Detective Agency novels as well as historic monuments commemorating key aspects of the foundation of Botswana and Gaborone. Enjoy a relaxed lunch before visiting Botswana Craft that has a wide array of crafts made by artisans across Botswana. Overnight: Aquarian Tide



DAY 14

Tour ends after breakfast, transfer to Gaborone Airport.
