

Kenya, Tanzania & Zanzibar Safari

21 Days

Day 1 – Arrive Nairobi

Welcome to Kenya! On arrival at Nairobi Airport, you'll be met and transferred to your accommodation. The remainder of the day is yours to relax after your journey.

Accommodation: Wildebeest Eco Camp or similar (1 night)

Meals: None

Day 2 – Nairobi to Nakuru

Travel through Kenya's scenic countryside to Nakuru, where you'll stay in charming self-contained farm cottages surrounded by relaxing gardens. This afternoon, join an optional guided farm walk, visit the inspiring Kenana Knitters Project, or simply unwind in the peaceful surroundings.

Accommodation: Kemu Farm Cottages or similar (2 nights)

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 3 – Lake Nakuru National Park

Spend today exploring Lake Nakuru National Park, renowned for its abundant wildlife and exceptional birdlife. The park is home to more than 400 bird species, including flamingos and fish eagles, along with both black and white rhinos. Keep an eye out for lions, giraffes, buffalo and other wildlife as you enjoy a full day of game viewing in one of Kenya's most scenic national parks.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 4 – Masai Mara

Journey into the legendary Masai Mara, one of Africa's premier wildlife destinations. Along the way, pass traditional Maasai communities before visiting a Maasai village to gain insight into their fascinating culture and semi-nomadic lifestyle. This afternoon, arrive at your luxury tented camp, perfectly positioned to immerse you in the African wilderness.

Accommodation: Oldarpoi Camp – Ensuite Permanent Safari Tent or similar (2 nights)

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 5 – Masai Mara Safari

Today is dedicated to discovering the incredible wildlife of the Masai Mara. Travelling in 4WD safari vehicles, search for the famous Big Five—lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhino—alongside vast herds of zebra, wildebeest, giraffe and antelope. Depending on the season, you may also witness the spectacular Great Migration.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 6 – Lake Naivasha

Travel to beautiful Lake Naivasha for a relaxing afternoon on the water. Cruise among pods of hippos while spotting fish eagles and abundant birdlife before visiting Elsamere, the former home of renowned conservationists Joy and George Adamson. Learn about Joy's extraordinary work with Elsa the lioness, made famous through *Born Free*, before enjoying a delightful afternoon tea in the gardens.

Accommodation: Camp Carnelly's or similar

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 7 – Nairobi

Drive through the spectacular Great Rift Valley, stopping at scenic viewpoints before returning to Nairobi. This evening, you may wish to dine at the famous Carnivore Restaurant.

Accommodation: Tamarind Tree Hotel or similar (2 nights)

Meals: Breakfast & Lunch

Day 8 – Free day

Enjoy a free day to relax, catch up on shopping, laundry or simply explore the city. An optional visit to the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust elephant orphanage is highly recommended (pre-booking required).

Meals: Breakfast

Day 9 – Nairobi to Arusha

Cross the border into Tanzania via Namanga before continuing to Arusha. Arrive mid-afternoon with free time to relax or explore this lively gateway to Tanzania's northern safari circuit.

Accommodation: Planet Lodge or similar

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 10 – Fly to Serengeti National Park

This morning, take a scenic flight into the world-famous Serengeti National Park. On arrival, meet your safari guides and begin an unforgettable game drive through one of Africa's greatest wildlife sanctuaries.

Accommodation: Golden Safari Camp – Ensuite Permanent Safari Tent or similar (2 nights)

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 11 – Serengeti Safari

Enjoy another full day exploring the endless plains of the Serengeti in search of predators, grazing herds and spectacular wildlife encounters.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 12 – Ngorongoro Crater & Karatu

Descend into the magnificent Ngorongoro Crater for an unforgettable safari before continuing to Karatu for the evening.

Accommodation: Kudu Lodge or similar

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 13 – Arusha

Visit the inspiring Shanga Foundation before returning to Arusha. Browse handcrafted products, enjoy lunch and learn about this remarkable social enterprise. Later, settle into your hotel.

Accommodation: Mt Meru Hotel or similar

Meals: Breakfast & Lunch

Day 14 – Marangu

Travel through colourful villages to Marangu, located on the slopes of Mount Kilimanjaro. Spend the afternoon relaxing in the gardens or by the pool.

Accommodation: Marangu Hotel or similar (2 nights)

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 15 – Chagga Cultural Experience

Explore Chagga villages, coffee plantations and ancient caves before sampling freshly roasted local coffee. Time permitting, cool off beneath a nearby waterfall.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 16 – Zanzibar

Fly to Zanzibar and spend the afternoon exploring the atmospheric streets of historic Stone Town before enjoying sunset over the Indian Ocean.

Accommodation: Forodhani Park Hotel or similar

Meals: Breakfast

Day 17 – Spice Tour & Nungwi Beach

Discover why Zanzibar became known as the Spice Island before travelling north to the beautiful beaches of Nungwi.

Accommodation: The Z Hotel or similar (3 nights)

Meals: Breakfast

Days 18/19 – Nungwi Beach

At leisure to relax or enjoy optional water activities.

Meals: Breakfast

Day 20 – Return to Stone Town

Return to Stone Town with free time for shopping or an optional visit to Prison Island. This evening, celebrate your adventure with a farewell dinner.

Accommodation: Forodhani Park Hotel or similar

Meals: Breakfast

Day 21 – Depart Zanzibar

Your adventure ends after breakfast (included). Airport transfers are available to Zanzibar Airport at any time today.
